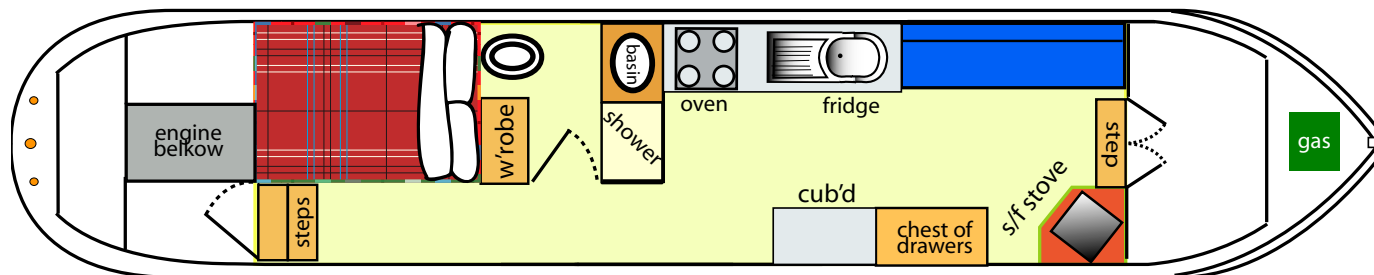

Functional narrowboat in the popular semi trad style built by Eastern Caravans and Narrowboats who have produced numerous canal craft over the years for both private owners and large hire fleets. At 36ft the boat is extremely easy to handle and relatively cheap to moor and license. There are no fancy add ons but the boat has a multi fuel stove, mains electric installed, a permanent double berth with a further make up double in the saloon. Full cooking facilities are installed. The exterior paintwork has faded, particularly on one side where the red paint has caught the sunlight over time. However, with a small amount of tlc this is an ideal starter boat without breaking the bank.
